June.

Decided that a present to the value of  
one guinea be given to Miss Elsie Thomas  
on the occasion of her marriage in recognition  
of her service as pianist at the Institute  
on numerous occasions.

Mr Eddie Rees to be asked to give  
tender for pointing and capping outer wall,  
and members of Committee undertook to be  
at the Institute on the following Monday evening  
to do preliminary work.
