

15th May 1933.

A meeting of Committee was held on the above date, when, in the absence of Mr. Rey through illness, Mr. Stancombe presided. In addition there were present Messrs E. Lovsmore, N. Adams, J. Jones (C) B. Jenkins, J. Jones (G) G. Adams and W.S. Noot.

Minutes of previous meeting read and adopted.

The chief, and indeed only item of business was to receive the Institute Accounts.

In presenting the Financial Statement up to, and including the 30th April 1933, the Secretary reported that Mr. G. Adams had had access to all the accounts and had inspected all Bank and other books. As all the particulars are filed with the Institute documents a detailed account is not being entered here. On the 30th April the overdraft at Bank stood at £20-7-6; against this there was outstanding 30/- in respect of hirings by the Women's Institute, thus reducing the actual indebtedness to Bank to £18/7/6. Considering the drop in the

Point-to-Point takings, and the difficulties experienced in raising funds during the past winter the report was considered satisfactory.

Decided that for the next few months at any rate, all efforts be concentrated on reducing the overdraft.
