A meeting of Committee was held on the above date, when, in the unavoidable absence of Mr. Ley, Mr. B. Jenkins presided. In addition there were present, Messrs W. Adams, J. Jones (C), J. Jones (G), E. Loosmore, R. Stancombe and W. S. North.

Minutes of previous meeting read and adopted.

Striking out of the minutes, Secretary reported on the 'staps' held so far this season: Five had been held, the total net proceeds being £2/11/3. It was decided that the dates of future

A short financial statement was presented which showed that at time of meeting overdraft stood at £21-14-5 against which were outstanding items of revenue totalling roughly £7, thus reducing indebtedness to Bank of £14-£15.

Hirings. In respect of hiring of Ante-room by W.I. An series of 3 Whist Knives, it was decided on the proposition of Mr Jones (C) seconded by Mr. A. Adams that a charge of 1/- per drive be made. For the use of the main building by the W.I. for a cookery Demonstration on Wednesday Nov 7th decided that a charge of 3/- be made. Proposed and seconded by Messrs Ledmore Jones (C) respectively that a charge of 2/6 be made for use of building for Public meeting in connection with Nursing Association. Mr Ledmore made application for Institute for Hospital Whist Knife & Dance on first Thursday in March 1935. Application granted, but question of charge deferred pending enquiries of charges for other buildings for similar event.

Billiard Tournaments. Decided that two Tournaments be held - Senior Junior.

- (a) Senior - Fee 3d entries close 12<sup>th</sup> Nov.  
(b) Junior - Fee 1d entries close 15<sup>th</sup> Nov.

In the Senior Tournament games, as usual, to be "100 up", but in the Juniors "60 up".

Request was received from local branch of British Legion for two "staps" to be held to raise funds for a Childrens party. Decided that request be granted.

A bill from Messrs S. Riley for 22/9 in respect of the stretching of the Billiard Cloth was passed for payment.

On the proposition of Mr Jones (C) seconded by Mr. J. Jones (G) it was decided to write to the Secretary of the <sup>Langston</sup> Johnston District Billiard League to the effect that Johnston Institute did not intend joining this year.

With regard to improving the lighting of the Institute, secretary instructed to write for particulars of 'Tulley' lamps, and also to enquire of the West Cambrian Electric Supply Co. as to the possibility of the village being supplied with electric light.

Decided that Mr Parrell be asked to fix a lock on door between the two rooms of Institute.
