A meeting of the Committee was held on the above date. In the unavoidable absence of Mr. Ley, Mr. D. Adams was voted to the chair. Present in addition were, Messrs J. Jones (C), J. Jones (A), G. Adams, D. Adams, E. Loosmore, A. Stancombe & W.S. Root.

Minutes of previous meeting read and adopted.

Report on "Stops" showed that the two held on 23rd and 29th March respectively had been very successful, the Institute funds benefiting to the extent of £3.11.1, and the Stop in progress at time of meeting gave every indication of being an equal success.

Decided that Mr. J. James's services as m.c. to the Stops be recognised in a tangible way, and ^{for} further this purpose the

Committee decided to spend a sum not exceeding 30/- on a present to be handed to Mr James at the Social on April 26th. Further decided that this presentation be made by Mr Ley.

With regard to Point-to-Point since the usual final arrangements, doorkeepers, water, etc were made; in addition, it was decided that prizes to the value of 15/- be purchased for the usual walking, etc. competitions. The Committee also confirmed the Secretary's action in engaging Mr. J. James as m.c.

It was understood that for the presentation of cups etc, the League would arrange with the appropriate gentlemen, in addition to whom this Committee would invite Councillor A.H. Codd. As to the nature of the social, decided that this matter be deferred to next meeting of Committee.
